



1. Steps to disable Auto Recovery/ Microsoft Excel 2007


Step 1. Open Excel 2007 & click on Office button. The Office button is located in the upper left corner of the screen.




Step 2. Click on **Excel Options** button, located at the bottom of this menu.




Step 3. Now you can see this window there are more options




Step 4. Now click on the save button so you see this window.



Step 5. There is a one check box. Save auto recover information every Now remove the tick mark.




Step 6. Click on "OK"




2 Steps to Disable Auto Recovery Microsoft Excel 2010


Step 1. Open Excel 2010 & click on Office button. The Office button is located in the upper left corner of the screen.




Step 2. Click on **Excel Options** button, located at the bottom of this menu.




Step 3. Now you can see this window there are more options.




Step 4. Now click on the **save button** so you see this window.



Step 5. There is a one check box. Save auto recover information every Now remove the tick mark.






3 Steps to Remove Auto Recovery Microsoft Excel 2010


Step 1. Open Excel 2010 & click on Office button. The Office button is located in the upper left corner of the screen.




Step 2. Click on **Excel Options** button, located at the bottom of this menu.




Step 3. Now you can see this window there is more option
